Wind Sock Kite



You will need:

- Cardstock or construction paper. Note: The kite can be made with any size of paper but larger paper will create a better kite. The thicker the paper the better it will withstand multiple uses.
- Streamers & Scissors (cut into 6-10 1-foot sections)
- Tape
- Wooden dowel
- String, cord or Rope (2.5 - 3 foot section)
- Markers and stickers to decorate

To make:

- Draw a pattern or picture on one side of the paper
- Flip the paper over, tape the pieces of streamer to the 'bottom' of the page (this should be the longer side of the paper)
- With the pattern side facing outwards and the streamers hanging downwards, create a circle with the paper, attach the two shorter sides with tape
- Place one end of the wooden dowel in the middle of your string, tie the string around the dowel. Secure the string by taping the knot to the dowel
- Tape the ends of the string inside the windsock at the opposite end to the streamers

To use:

- If weather allows, get outside!
- Run around with the kite to see the streamers dance! The faster you make the kite move the more the streamers will swing in the wind!
