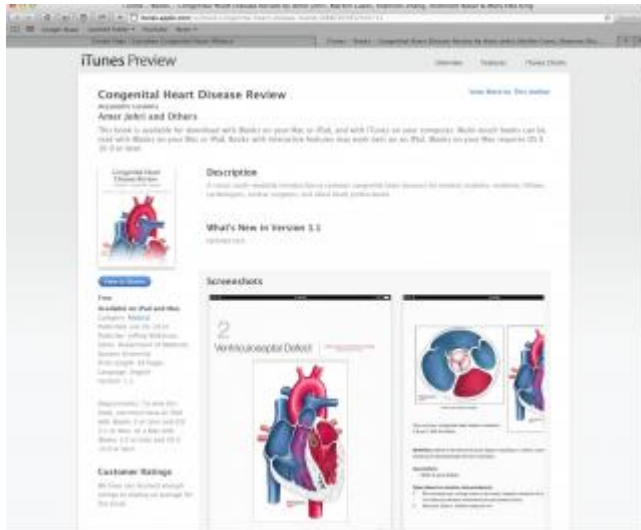




Congenital Heart Disease Review
